1. maps - flat models of the Earth; pictures that help people find places
2. globe - a sphere; a round model of the Earth
3. symbols - important marks on the key and map that stand for something real
4. equator - imaginary line around the center of the Earth
5. hemispheres - the northern, southern, eastern, and western "halves" of the Earth
6. map key - shows symbols on a map
7. legend - another name for map key
8. continents - large land masses of the Earth
9. oceans - large bodies of water on the Earth
10. compass rose - shows direction on a map
11. The four cardinal directions are north, south, east, and west. (primary)
12. The four intercardinal directions are northwest, northeast, southwest, southeast. (intermediate)
13. The Arctic Ocean surrounds the North Pole.
14. North America has 3 countries on it---the United States of America, Canada, and Mexico. Canada is north of the U.S.A., and Mexico is south of the U.S.A.
15. The seven continents are: North America, South America, Africa, Asia, Europe, Australia, and Antarctica.
16. The four oceans are: Atlantic, Pacific, Indian, and Arctic.
